

**Redmond Gymnastics Academy

Old Business:

Fundraisers:

The following are fundraisers that are being proposed. No formal action was taken.

- Texas Hold'em Tournament:
 - Tim and Angela Jordison, and Jeff and Jennifer Hake are willing to organize a tournament. They have requested the booster club be in charge of the food. They want to have the tournament November 7, 2008 pending board approval. At this time the location is still pending. The old RSC build may be a possibility if the building is not subleased.
- Melanie and Scott Hill would like to organize a 50/50 raffle in the community. Parents and gymnasts would sell tickets and a drawing would be held. Scott will be checking to see if would be possible to have the drawing at the second to the last Varsity football game at Redmond High School. If this is not possible then it could be held at the gym, no date or time has been determined. Ticket cost will be \$1 per ticket or 6 for \$5.
- Melanie Hill and Dee Dee Cashwell are researching the option of putting together a gymnast's calendar. The calendar would consist of pictures of the gymnasts and its intent is for family, friends and possible sponsors to purchase. No further details were available.

- Mud Volleyball:
 - The board members will review the mud volleyball website to make changes for this next year's fundraiser and the newly created sponsorship level program. This will be discussed at the November 4, 2008 board meeting.
