The following are key items that were discussed:

- Still waiting on the Certificate of Liability Insurance coming from AIC Insurance for the County permit.

- John Holland and Kevin Story will meet at the tournament site on Monday, August 11 at 6 pm to start building the four volleyball courts. RSC will be supplying two bobcats and operators to construct the courts.
- Kevin will be contacting parents to come out and help.
- John Holland gave a brief overview of the layout for the courts we will be constructing.
- John Holland received a quote from Ace Hardware in Redmond for 200 ft. of coated cable to use for holding the nets in place. The quote consisted of \$0.50 ft. verses the regular price of \$0.79 per ft.
- Nolan Bourne has access thru Overhead Doors and will check on pricing for non-coated cable to see if we can get better pricing.
- The following items still need to be purchased or borrowed to complete the courts.
 - One additional pole.
 - 200 ft. of cable.
 - One net coming from Teresa Schweitzer
 - Misc. bolts.
- Also still in need of the following items:
 - One additional sandwich board (Kevin Story may have a board to donate).
 - Sponsorship banner.
 - One volleyball.
- Geno's Pizza donated a P.A. System (Karaoke machine) and operator for use during the tournament.
- Kevin Story contacted Mike Chaney of Combined Communication regarding a cash donation and was told they do not donate cash. However, they have donated airtime on all four of their radio stations and have estimated their donation to be in the \$2,500 dollar range.
