Fundraisers:

- A recommendation to the board to have a booster club store to fundraise for the booster club was presented by Mohini Haken. The club would sale items such as pins, books, socks, tape, and pre-wrap and has been approved by the Redmond Gymnastics Academy owner Jamie Ellingsen to do the sales at the gym.
